Your safety is always the first priority

Your Woodworks runs under a stringent Safety Management Plan for your protection.

When you use Your Woodworks facilities, you must complete an induction and comply with the basic workshop rules specified in the Plan. We enforce a strict policy of "no induction, no workshop access".

You also need to be aware of your legal Duty of Care under the *Occupational Safety and Health Act 1984* to look after your own safety and the safety of others at work. The aim of this legislation is to prevent anyone being killed, injured or contracting an illness due to work activities, including the use of plant and equipment, at a workplace.

Induction

For your safety and the safety of others in the workshop, you must complete an induction before using Your Woodworks facilities for the first time.

At the beginning of the induction, you will be asked to supply the following information:

- your name and contact details
- proof of identity
- information about your experience to allow us to give you access to workshop machines and to assess how much staff assistance you will need

Our staff will then give you a short general induction, which includes:

- workshop rules
- safety procedures
- workshop layout
- toilet facilities

WORKSHOP RULES DOWNLOAD (198 words)

Workshop rules

1. Persons under the age of 15 will not be permitted in the workshop area, unless supervised by an approved adult.
2. Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
3. Anyone exhibiting inappropriate behaviour or under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be refused entry or requested to leave.
4. You are required to wear appropriate clothing, shoes and personal protection equipment (PPE). Thongs, loose clothing and torn clothing are not permitted.
5. Personal safety protection should be worn at all times. We strongly recommend you bring your own PPE. However, safety equipment is available on the premises.
6. Follow machinery safe operation procedures (SOP) and check machinery settings before use.
7. Follow staff instructions and ask staff for assistance if necessary.
8. Report equipment malfunctions IMMEDIATELY.
9. Staff will check all materials you bring into the workshop for imbedded nails, coatings and other hazards.
10. You are responsible for your materials. We accept no responsibility for your materials while on the premises.
11. You must leave the machinery and the workshop safe and clean.
12. You must report and pay for any breakages and damaged equipment, including cutters and saw blades.
